LIMITED VISITATION ALERT

To help protect our patients, providers, employees and community, the following visitation guidelines are in effect immediately:



Anyone entering our facility will be **screened for symptoms consistent with COVID-19**, based on CDC guidelines.



Patients who are allowed visitors may have only **one WELL visitor** per day. **WELL** visitors must be 18 years of age or older and will be required to wear a mask during their visit.

One WELL visitor is allowed for patients on these units:

- Outpatient Surgical Services
- Outpatient Ancillary

Emergency Room patients are allowed **one WELL** visitor.

Labor & Delivery patients are allowed **one WELL** support person with them for their entire hospital visit.

Pediatric patients will be allowed **one WELL** parent or guardian only.

End-of-life and clinical necessity exceptions apply.

Visitors **ARE NOT** allowed for the following patient areas:

Patients on these units: Telemetry (5th floor) & Medical/Surgical (4th floor).

Located in intensive care and behavioral health.

Patients in isolation, immunocompromised, or are under observation or test positive for COVID-19.



Additional **WELL** friends and family (beyond the one designated visitor) should **remain at home**.

Visitors who do not meet screening criteria at entry will be asked to reschedule their visit until they are symptom-free.
