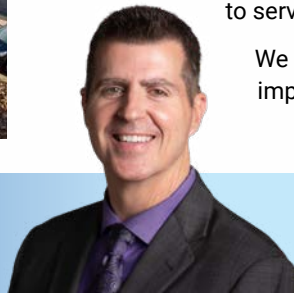

Invested more than \$4.1 million in capital improvements
